



the Commission for providing information sought by her and take action against the erring officers in accordance with the RTI Act.

RTI application enclosed with the complaint reveal that the application is written on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 50/- under which following information from PIO Education Department has been sought: -

**“Copy of panel framed for selection of ReT Teachers in SSA P/s Usmania Mohallah Samsuna, Advertisement Notice, Newspapers in which advertisement notice was published, tentative selection list, formal order of engaged candidates, qualification certificates of Nuzhat Akhter, joining report, Court order”.**

Shri Ashiq Hussain, who appeared on behalf of CEO Anantnag, submitted that desired information sought by the information seeker has been sent to him through Registered Post on 08.01.2014. Upon perusal of the information provided viz-a-viz RTI application, the Commission has found that information sought in the RTI application has been provided in full.

The Commission has noted that the fee accompanying RTI application is in the shape of non-judicial stamp paper which is not in accordance with the prescribed mode of payment as provided under

section 3 of the RTI Rules 2012; even then PIO has provided information free of cost to the information seeker. It is therefore evident that there is no malifide intention on the part of PIO as the RTI application was deficient in respect of mode of payment of fee.

The complaint is accordingly disposed of.
