Brief facts of the case are that an RTI application has been filed by Shri Shakeel Ahmad Dar s/o Abdul Aziz Dar r/o Batapora, Shopian before PIO/Chief Education Officer Shopian on 03.08.2013 seeking following information: -

1. "Order regarding constitution of committee regarding verification of documents, initial engagement order, qualification certificates and pay acquaintance rolls of the CPWs of School Education Deptt. District Shopian.
2. All other communication between verification committee an the Chief Education Officer Shopian. Besides the circular/SRO

under which the eligibility order fixed by the Govt. for regularization of CPWs.

3. Service particulars of Graduate CPWs of District Shopian”.

This RTI application has been transferred by ADC Shopian to CEO Shopian directing him to provide information as sought by the applicant directly under intimation to his office.

Thereafter applicant has filed First Appeal which has been decided by ADC on 14.11.2013 asking CEO Shopian to provide requisite information to the applicant within three days positively.

As no information was received within stipulated period after the order of the FAA, the applicant filed Second Appeal before the Commission on 02.12.2013. Upon perusal of the appeal, it was seen that the First Appeal was not filed before appropriate FAA, which in this case is Directorate of School Education Kashmir and therefore Appeal filed before the Commission was treated as a complaint.

In counter reply to the notice of the Commission, CEO Shopian submitted that the applicant was provided information vide letter NO. CEO/RTI/SPN/601 dated 21.11.2013 through ordinary post. With regard to delay, CEO has submitted that there was complete shutdown in Shopian town for about 28 days due to killing of 4 persons in the month of September 2013.

The Commission also received a communication from the complainant wherein he has informed that he has received the

information from CEO on 14.12.2013 through Registered Post and has requested the Commission to treat the appeal as withdrawn.

In view of the fact that the information has been provided to the information seeker and he has withdrawn his complaint, no further action is warranted and the complaint is disposed of.
