The Commission received a complaint on 15.11.2012 from Shri Gh. Mohammad Khan, Union President Deprived Anganwadi Workers/Helper of Block Rajwar and Ramhal Kupwara against CDPO Rajwar and Ramhal District Kupwara stating that he submitted an RTI application on 19.09.2012 before CDPO but till date has not received any information and has accordingly requested for a thorough investigation be initiated as to why he has been deprived of the information which is basic right of every state subject.

The complainant appeared before the Commission on 16.04.2012 and produced photocopy of Registered Post dated 24.09.2012 as evidence of RTI application sent to CDPO Rajwar Handwara.

In response to the notice of the Commission dated 17.04.2013, Shri Mohammad Ayooob Wani, CDPO Ramhal (then CDPO Rajwar) appeared in the

Commission and filed counter statement submitting therein that he has been transferred from ICDS Project Rajwar on 26.12.2012 and he did not receive the earlier notices of the Commission.

PIO/CDPO during hearing submitted that during his tenure all applications under RTI has been disposed of and no such application was pending during his tenure. PIO produced RTI Movement Register in support of his statement wherein movement of RTI applications received/disposed have been maintained since 25.06.2011 and this RTI application is not entered therein. PIO also contested the evidence of Registered Post as it do not indicate the subject matter nor acknowledgement thereof has been produced.

In view of the above facts, copy of the RTI application alongwith receipt of fee is provided to the PIO with the directions to dispose of the same afresh as provided under section 7 of J&K RTI Act, 2009 and submit compliance report to the Commission.

With above directions the complaint is disposed of.
