3. If you have laid down the criteria B.CA/M.CA for recruitment of Data Entry Operators, please furnish me a detailed circular or any valid document from higher authorities.

In response to the notice of Commission dated 22.10.2013, Chief Medical Officer Bandipora vide letter dated 26.10.2013 submitted that the information sought by the applicant has been dispatched to him vide his No. 429 dated 30.08.2013 to the address mentioned by the RTI applicant through ordinary post, but it seems that the RTI applicant has not received the information well in time. Accordingly the said information has again been forwarded to the RTI applicant through Registered Post and an evidence thereof produced postal receipt dated 26.10.2013 before the Commission. Sh. Mohsin Bhat, information seeker admitted to have received the information.

Upon perusal of the information provided it is evident that information asked for has been provided. However, information seeker denied to have received the information earlier, as referred to by CMO Bandipora. Since no evidence has been produced by representative of CMO Bandipora in this regard, CMO Bandipora is directed to explain the reason for delay alongwith evidence within 3 weeks from the issue of this order.

The complaint is accordingly disposed of.
