Briefly the facts in this appeal are that S. Kulbir Singh S/o S. Teja Singh R/o House No. 53/13 Sector 10, Guru Nanak Nagar, Jammu has sought certain information in his RTI application filed before Director Land Record, Jammu relating to name, parentage and address of the applicant who has approached the Director Land Record, Jammu under which the letter No. 739/DLR/AP dated 15-03-2006 has been submitted to Financial Commissioner, Revenue J&K Government, Jammu for revision of mutation No. 706 under section 121 for Khasra no. 147, land measuring 8 marlas of village Thanger, Tehsil Jammu.

The Regional Director, Survey and land Record, Ex-officio Settlement Officer, Jammu in his counter statement supported by an affidavit duly sworn before Tehsildar, Executive Magistrate Ist Class, Jammu has submitted that the application sought by the information seeker has not been traced out from the record. However, the appeal was lodged by Captain Dewan Singh S/o Thaker Dham Singh R/o Manda Quarter, through Attorney holder Sardar Tejinder Paul Singh S/o S. Ranjet Singh R/o Digiana Jammu versus i). Tehsildar Settlement, Jammu ii). S. Kulbir Singh S/o S. Teja Singh R/o House No. 53/13 Sector 10, Guru Nanak Nagar, Jammu was subjudice for mutation No. 706 dated 24-04-2005

before the Court of Director Land Records with the power of Collector Agrarian Reforms, Jammu and the same appeal has been dismissed as withdrawn on 26-08-2005. The PIO further submitted in the counter statement that the copies of the decisions can be provided to the applicant. However, the office of Director Land Records does not have in specific name, parentage and address of the applicant who approached the Director Land Records, Jammu.

From the aforesaid facts, it is apparent that whatever information was available in the office record has already been furnished to the applicant vide office letter No:RDCLR/J/254 dated 14-12-2013 by the Regional Director, Survey and Land Records, Jammu. The Registry is directed to furnish certified of an affidavit and other related documents filed by the Regional Director, Survey and Land Records, Jammu filed before the Commission as part of the counter statement to the information seeker on payment of requisite fee.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
