Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Adarsh Kohli S/o Smt. Krishna Wanti W/o Sh. Amar Nath Kohli R/o H.No. 440, near Krishan Jyotshi Temple, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu moved an application dated 06-07-2013 under J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 before the PIO O/o Sr. Superintendent of Police, Jammu (DSP/PIO, H.Q. Jammu) whereunder he sought certain information interalia relating to his application dated 04-03-2013 filed at Police Station Bakshi Nagar, Jammu with regard to threat to the complainant. The PIO/Dy. S.P. HQ, Jammu vide office letter no. RTI/2013/108/2462-63 dated 01-08-2013 informed the information seeker that the matter was got enquired through Supdt. of Police City North, Jammu and report obtained vide letter no. 9683/SPCN dated 29-07-2013 is enclosed herewith. The letter dated 29-07-2013 of S.P. City North, Jammu interalia reads that order passed by Hon'ble City Judge, Jammu titled Adarsh Kohli V/s Amar Nath Kohli was received at Police Station, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu and implemented on ground through Head Constable Zuber Mirza No. 1112/J of P/S Bakshi Nagar and compliance report has been submitted to the concerned court vide letter no. 720/5-1 dated 15-07-2013. However, the information seeker

was not satisfied with the information provided to him preferred 1st appeal dated 05-09-2013 before the FAA/SP Hqrs, Jammu and was informed vide order no. 9932/SPhqrs dated 01-10-2013 and the information sought by the information seeker was furnished to him which was enclosed as annexure-A to the above said letter.

The information seeker challenged the aforesaid orders of the PIO/FAA in 2nd appeal dated 18-11-2013 before the Commission. The matter was listed for hearing on 21-01-2014 at Jammu office of the Commission. Both the parties were present and the contents of information provided to the information seeker was discussed threadbare. During the course of proceedings certain discrepancies in the information provided to the information seeker were brought to the notice of the Commission and the PIO readily agreed to rectify the same.

In view of the aforesaid facts and observations, the PIO is hereby directed to provide the revised information relating to queries no. 1 & 2 of the RTI application of the information seeker as per office record under an intimation to the Commission.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
