Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Raj Kumar S/o Sh. Anant Ram R/o 127/9 Keran Gurah, Bantalab, Jammu moved an application dated 24-10-2013 before the Director, Forensic Science Laboratory, Jammu under J&K RTI Act, 2009 whereunder he sought certain information for filling up of Class-IV posts in Forensic Science Laboratory, Jammu.

The Directorate of Forensic Science Laboratory, Jammu vide office letter No:DFSL/RTI/GB/2013/2461 dated 13-11-2013 furnished the requisite information to the information seeker (enclosures two leaves) within the statutory period as laid down under the Act. However, the information seeker was not satisfied with the information provided to him, preferred Ist appeal dated 16-11-2013 before Director, Forensic Science

Laboratory, Jammu. The Director, Forensic Science Laboratory, Jammu/FAA disposed off the said appeal vide No: DFSL/RTI/GB/2013/2571 dated 10-11-2013 and the applicant was advised that in case he needs the information regarding 12<sup>th</sup> class percentage of candidates, he may deposit fee of Rs.10/- for that purpose as his Ist RTI application was disposed off accordingly and information was communicated to him vide office letter No: DFSL/RTI/GB/2013/2461 dated 13-11-2013. The FAA also intimated to the applicant the criteria of the selection for the posts of Laboratory Attendants/Orderly. Feeling aggrieved of the aforesaid order of the FAA, the appellant preferred second appeal dated 24-12-2013 before the Commission in which he has alleged that the Directorate of Forensic Science Laboratory, Jammu has provided him incorrect and misleading information.

Perusal of the documents available on record show that the information as sought by the information seeker in his RTI application was furnished to him within the statutory period and PIO submitted before the Commission that the information provided to the information seeker was as per the office record and nothing has been concealed. Moreover, in this case, the appellant has sought certain information in Ist appeal which was not requested by him in his RTI application. The PIO is expected to provide only that information which is requested in the RTI application. Additional information can't be sought in Ist/IIInd appeal by the appellant. Thus, the allegation levelled by the appellant that the information provided to him is incorrect and misleading is baseless and frivolous. The second appeal preferred by the appellant is without merit and hence dismissed.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
