Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Mohd. Ayub Ayan, State Secretary, Jammu and Kashmir Peoples Democratic Front, Camp Office Mahore moved an application dated 24-09-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO O/o PWD, Special Sub-Division, Mahore whereunder he sought certain information interalia relating to construction of road from Arnas to Mahore etc.

The PIO/Executive Engineer, PWD (R&B) Spl. Sub-Division, Mahore vide office letter no. 12116-17 dated 30-01-2014 informed the Commission that the information stands already submitted to the information seeker vide his office letter no. 9050 dated 21-11-2013 by post. The PIO also submitted the photocopy of the information provided to the information seeker for the perusal of the Commission. The counter statement and the letter of information have been placed in the file for reference and record.

The Commission after receiving the 2nd appeal of the information seeker, listed the matter for hearing on 12-02-2014 at Jammu office of the Commission. During the

course of proceedings held today, the RTI application and the information provided to the information seeker was discussed and it was found that the information is incomplete in some respects and is not in conformity with his RTI application. The PIO agreed to provide the revised information to the information seeker as per his RTI application subject to its availability in the office record and sought two week's time for the same.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and observations, the PIO is hereby directed to furnish the revised information to the information seeker under registered cover within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order under an intimation to the Commission. The PIO is further directed that in case the information seeker desires to inspect the record in his office, he may be provided the facility to do the same during office hours on a working day. The parties are at liberty to settle the date and time for inspection of record which may be convenient to them.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
