Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Shri Z.A.Qazi, Advocate moved an application dated 07-10-2013 before P.I.O in the office of Director, Health Services, Jammu under Jammu and Kashmir Right to Information Act, 2009 whereunder he sought the following information:-

1. Kindly provide the detailed report/information regarding salary details of all contractual drivers in whole Jammu province i.e in all ten districts w.e.f 1.1.2000 upto July 2009 and after July 2009 upto September, 2013 and who are still working as contractual driver.
2. Kindly provide the detailed report/information regarding present place of posting of these drivers.

The PIO after receiving the RTI application collected the requisite information from all the concerned districts of Jammu province and furnished the same to the information seeker. However, the information seeker in his second appeal alleged that information provided to him is incomplete and not as per his RTI application. The Commission after receiving the second appeal listed the matter for hearing on 26-2-2014. The appellant was directed to provide details to the PIO about the hospitals relating to whom the information was still awaited and the PIO after receiving details from the appellant contacted the concerned hospitals for seeking the information requested by the appellant. The matter was again listed for hearing on 27-03-2014. During the course of proceedings the PIO apprised the Commission that the requisite information as obtained from the various hospitals in Jammu province have been furnished to the appellant and the latter also acknowledged the receipt of the same. However, the appellant brought to the notice of the Commission that he has not received the information relating to Ramban district. The PIO agreed to do the needful and assured the Commission that the information relating to Ramban district will also be provided to the information seeker within two weeks.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and observations, the PIO is hereby directed to furnish the information relating to hospitals in Ramban district within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order under an intimation to the Commission.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
