Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Ghulam Mohd. S/o Abdullah Khakhmat R/o Bathoie, Tehsil Mahore, District Reasi moved an application dated 04-04-2012 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO/ Block Development Officer, Mahore for seeking certain information.

Feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO, the information seeker approached the FAA/Director, Rural Development Department, Jammu by filing an appeal dated 13-06-2012. The PIO as well as Mohd. Ayub Ayan representative of the appellant were present before the FAA. The First Appellate Authority disposed of the appeal vide its order NO:DRDJ/RTI/119/5914-18 dated 27-06-2012 and observed that the PIO/BDO Mahore has failed to provide requisite information to the information seeker within stipulated period as prescribed under RTI Act, 2009. The PIO/BDO Mahore was directed to provide the requisite information to the information seeker free of cost within 10 days through registered post and was also warned to remain careful in future in complying with the provisions of RTI

Act, 2009. The information seeker feeling aggrieved of non-compliance of the order of the FAA, filed second appeal dated 11-01-2013 before the Commission and has alleged that he has not been provided the information as per his RTI application. The Commission after receiving appeal filed by the information seeker directed the PIO to send counter reply to this Commission within 7 days from receipt of the notice. The matter was listed for hearing on 20-03-2013 and PIO authorized Sh. Miran Bakash I/c Inspector Block Mahore to remain present for hearing before the Commission as the PIO was out of station in connection with some official assignment. During the course of proceedings held today Sh. Miran Bakash I/c Inspector Block Mahore apprised the Commission that BDO Mahore is undergoing training in connection with his official duties at Srinagar and thus authorized him to remain present before the Commission. Sh. Miran Bakash I/c Inspector submitted a letter bearing NO: BDOM/12-13/882-85 dated 08-03-2013 which was addressed to the Commission and wherein BDO Mahore has submitted that the information was provided to the applicant vide office letter NO: BDOM/12-13/416-17 dated 03-07-2012. The copy of the aforesaid letter was also endorsed to the information seeker. Sh. Miran Bakash representative of the PIO further informed the Commission that the information as available in office record was furnished to the information seeker free of cost under a registered cover. He also provided the details of information relating to MGNREGA work wire Plan for the year 2010, 2011, 2012, IAY List for the year 2010, 2011,2012, CDF works wise list for the year 2011,12 and submitted the same for perusal of the Commission. After going through the record, Commission is of the opinion that the information as sought by the information seeker stands furnished to him. Thus no further direction in the matter is required.

The appeal is disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
