Briefly the facts in this complaint are that Sh. Gh. Hassan Wani S/o Mohd. Asan Wani R/o Herpora, Tehsil and District Shopian, Kashmir A/o Hotel Heewan, Srinagar moved an application dated 23-01-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO/ Divisional Commissioner, Jammu seeking the information :-

- 1. That what is the criteria of the screening committee for migrants for clearing/rejecting the claim of applicants for the grant of registration as migrants with relief organization and consequently grant of relief.*
- 2. How many persons who are political workers have been cleared by the screening committee under the chairmanship of Div. Commissioner Jammu and granted Registration under relief category and consequential relief assistance granted.*

3. *What is the criteria for grant of relief benefits to militancy victim cases and if the screening committee has cleared the case of any political worker since the concept of this screening committee was conceived and implemented.*
4. *Information regarding the minutes of meeting dated 10-01-2013 at Jammu.*
5. *What is the fate of my file regarding registration under relief category before the Commissioner Relief and Rehabilitation canal road Jammu.*

b) Department: Chairman Screening Committee for Migrants office of Divisional Commissioner Jammu.

The PIO/Assistant Commissioner, (Revenue Attorney) with Divisional Commissioner, Jammu transferred the aforesaid application to the PIO office of the Relief and Rehabilitation Commissioner, (Migrant) Jammu vide office letter No: 601/RA/RTI/1431-32 dated 23-01-2013. The aforesaid letter and application of the information seeker was received by the office of PIO/Relief Organization Jammu on 02-02-2013. The applicant had filed another application on 30-03-2013 which was received in the office of PIO/Relief Organization Jammu on 20-04-2013. During the course of proceedings held today, the PIO/Relief Organization Jammu submitted before the Commission that both the applications of the information seeker has been disposed of and he was supplied information vide office letter NO: RRCM/PIO/RTI/871 dated 08-04-2013 and No :RRCM/RIT/PIO/924 dated 09-05-2013 respectively.

The PIO/Relief Organization, Jammu further submitted that information as available in office record was furnished to the information seeker as expeditiously as possible because information was to be collected and collated from the office record. In view of

the aforesaid facts, it is manifested that the information as sought by the information seeker furnished to him. Thus, no further direction in the matter is required.

The complaint is accordingly disposed of.
