Briefly the facts in this appeal are that S. ManMohan Singh Bhatia S/o Sh. Bhagat Singh R/o 71, Shastri Nagar, Jammu moved an application dated 28-01-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO, J&K Board of School Education, Rehari Colony, Jammu seeking the following information :-

1. Furnish me that JKBOSE in its Notification No: F(Admn-B) cu/99 dated 22-10-99 invited applications from unemployed youths for the posts of Kashmir province and posts in Jammu province total posts 7+6=13 and JKBOSE declared selection list of Jr. Assistant vide No: F(Admn-B) cu/99 dated 22-10-99 in which 24 candidates are shown selected. Give me a detail report that how 24 candidates are selected against 13 advertised posts.

2. Furnish me the copy of each and every newspaper with D.I.P No. in which 3 posts are advertised.
3. Furnish me the copy of the Newspaper with D.I. P No. in which JKBOSE declare selection list of the selected 24 candidates.

Having received no response from the PIO, the information seeker preferred Ist appeal dated 2-03-2013 before the First Appellate Authority i.e Secretary Board of School Education, Jammu. Feeling aggrieved of the order tthe First Appellate Authority, he preferred second appeal dated 15-04-2013 before the Commission. The Commission vide its notice No:SIC/J/84/2013/1969-70 dated 2-05-2013 directed the PIO to appear before the Commission on 17-05-2013 and file counter statement. The perusal of the order of the First Appellate Authority shows that information seeker was informed that the information with regard to point 1 and 3 shall be provided soon after the office resumes its functioning at Srinagar by PIO BOSE from Srinagar, after move, as the information sought by the information seeker was not ready and the same was scattered across the State and information was as old as of 15 years. During the course of proceedings held today the information seeker was furnished a copy of the order of the FAA and PIO assured the Commission that the order of the FAA shall be implemented in letter and spirit within a week's time.

In view of the aforesaid facts and assurance given by the PIO, it is hereby ordered that the information relating to point 1 and 3 shall be furnished to the information seeker under registered cover within a week's time from the date of receipt of this order under an intimation to the Commission.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
