Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Gurmukh Singh S/o Lt. S.Tara Singh R/o Village Deep Nagar, Kunjwani, Tehsil Jammu moved an application dated 10.11.2012 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO, office of the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu seeking the following information:-

- 1. A complaint was submitted before the State Vigilance Organization, J&K Srinagar in which regard request was made before the PIO, State Vigilance Org; J&K Srinagar for providing information action taken in the complaint. In reply under RTI Act information was provided that a true copy of letter no. SVO-JD-JSC-23/05-13235-36 dated 06-10-2005 addressed to Div. Commissioner, Jammu was provided. Subsequently, 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority, State Vigilance Organization, J&K Srinagar under Order No. 255 of 2012 dated 17-10-2012 provided me with the copy of letter supra.*

*Information be provided about;*

- a. *Under which conditions the size of land measuring 13 marlas comprising Khasra No. 491 in Village Deeli, Tehsil Jammu was increased to 1 kanal and 13 marlas which position continued upto year 1988 till the land was sold by Ghar Singh R/o Seer, R.S. Pura, Jammu. During the verification the identity of the then corrupt revenue officials are identified as Sh. Chatro Ram and the then Naib Tehsildar Shamsheer Singh. What action has been initiated against these revenue officials and what orders has been passed reducing the land from 1 kanal 13 marlas to its actual size 13 marlas comprising Khasra No. 491 of Village Deeli, Tehsil Jammu.*
- b. *About action taken on report of Vigilance Organization, J&K Srinagar submitted before the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu under no. SVO-JD-ISC-23/05-13235-36.*
- Copy of the letter is enclosed alongwith the Order no. 255 of 2012 dated 17-10-2012 of 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority, State Vigilance Organization, J&K, Srinagar for reference.*
- c. *About why the case against the corrupt / erred revenue officials named in the letter supra is not ordered for registration with the competent Anti-Corruption Court, Jammu through State Vigilance Organization, Jammu under norms.*

The application of the applicant was forwarded by the then PIO in the office of the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide office letter no. 601/RA/RTI/1046-48 dated 17-11-2012 U/s 6 of the J&K RTI Act, 2009 to PIO office of the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu and PIO office of the Settlement Officer, Jammu to provide the requisite information to the applicant as per RTI Act and a copy was also endorsed to the applicant for information. The PIO office of the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu informed the Commission vide office letter no. DCJ/PIO/RTI/2013-14/207-08 dated 17-05-2013 that the RTI application of the applicant was received in his office vide I.D. No. 691 dated 27-09-2012 and the same was forwarded to the complaint cell for assistance U/s 5(4) & 5(5) of J&K RTI Act, 2009 vide office no. DCJ/PIO/RTI/2012-13/2889-90 dated 05-10-2012. The complaint cell vide their letter no. DCJ/Complaint/769 dated 16-11-2012

submitted a reply which was furnished to the applicant on 23-11-2012 by the Assistant Commissioner (Rev.), Jammu the then PIO in the case. A copy of the letter was also sent by post to the information seeker.

The PIO further submitted that after completion of the inquiry the Assistant Settlement Officer, Jammu vide his letter no. ASO/R/13/1482 dated 13-03-2013 and ASO/R/13/1483 dated 13-03-2013 submitted the reports to the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu. The copies of the aforesaid reports of Assistant Settlement Officer, Jammu were submitted for the perusal of the Commission and have been placed in the file for reference and record. During the course of proceedings held today, the information as sought by the information seeker in his RTI application was furnished to him, thus no further direction in the matter is required.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
