Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Hari Krishan S/o Sh. Baldev Raj R/o Jamotian, P.O Mawa Brahmana, Tehsil Akhnoor, District Jammu moved an application dated 9-02-2013 under the J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO District Education Officer, Jammu seeking the following information:-

1. Appointment of teachers under SSA from 2000 to till date with minimum and maximum qualification from Bhartiya Shiksha Parishad, U.P with proof of receipt and dispatch.
2. Photocopy of dispatch register of CEO office Jammu for the year 2012 i.e 01-01-2012 to 31-12-2012 and till date.
3. Photo copy of relieving order of staff attached in CEO office and other schools in district Jammu as per directions given by Deputy C.M i.e Education Minister.
4. Certificate from all offices that all the deployed employees has been relieved till date.

It has been alleged that the PIO/CEO did not furnish any information within statutory period. The information seeker preferred appeal dated 12-03-2013 before the FAA i.e Director School Education, Jammu which remains subjudice and has not been disposed of till date. Thus feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO as well as FAA, the appellant knocked the doors of the Commission by filing second appeal and requesting therein that the PIO be directed to furnish the requisite information as per his RTI application.

However, the PIO, Directorate of School Education Jammu informed the Commission vide office letter No. DSEJ/RTI-2013/6120-24 dated 11-06-2013:-

1. That the application of information seeker has not been received by Directorate which was addressed to PIO.
2. That the information seeker filed 1st appeal without applying to PIO.
3. That the appeal was fixed for hearing on 15-04-2013.
4. That after examining the case file it was found that the information seeker requested for information in four points which pertained to CEO/PIO Jammu.
5. The FAA directed undersigned to take up the matter with CEO Jammu and accordingly the application was referred to CEO Jammu vide 5688-89 dated 23-04-2013.

The perusal of the aforesaid letter further shows that the information seeker without submitting the application to the PIO filed the first appeal. The FAA acted with promptness and referred the application of the information seeker to CEO, Jammu. In view of the given circumstances, the information seeker is advised to approach CEO Jammu as the information pertains to the office of CEO Jammu to whom his application stands transferred vide letter No:5688-89 dated 23-04-2013. The CEO, Jammu is also directed to ensure that the information is furnished to the information seeker as expeditiously as possible but not later than two weeks from the date of receipt of this order under an intimation to the Commission.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
