Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. M.K. Sharma S/o Sh. R.L. Sharma R/o Prem Nagar, Miran Sahib, R.S. Pura, Jammu moved an application dated 31-10-2012 under J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 before the PIO / Tehsil Supply Officer, R.S. Pura, Jammu seeking certain information relating to kerosine oil dealership and undertaking taken from the concerned ration dealers etc. The PIO furnished parawise reply to the information seeker vide office letter no. 0991/TSO/CAPD/RSP/2012 dated 13-12-2012. But the information seeker being not satisfied with the information provided to him, preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 10-12-2012 before the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellate Authority in pursuant to which PIO Jammu (Rural) was directed to submit report to the FAA within 15 days but the PIO, Jammu (Rural) did not furnish any report thus causing denial of information to the information seeker.

Feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO and order passed by the FAA, the information seeker preferred 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal dated 29-04-2013 before the Commission in which he has requested that the direction be issued to the PIO / FAA to provide information strictly as sought by him in the RTI application. The

matter was listed for hearing on 11-06-2013. The appellant and the APIO / TSO, R.S. Pura were present. During the course of proceedings, the appellant apprised the Commission that information requested by him has not been provided to him and whatever has been furnished i.e. is erroneous, incomplete and incorrect and does not correspond to his RTI application. The perusal of the documents on record shows that the information sought by the information seeker is voluminous in nature and involves the scrutiny of record with effect from April, 2005 till date. The APIO submitted before the Commission that the appellant is free to inspect the record in his office and he will provide him the necessary facility for the same. In view of the assurance given by the APIO, Sh. Narinder Pal Singh TSO, R.S. Pura is hereby directed that the appellant be allowed the facility to access the record in his office on any working day during office hours and provide him the certified copies of relevant documents required by him free of cost. The parties are further directed to settle date and time for inspection of record which is mutually convenient to them. The TSO, R.S. Pura is further directed to seek a certificate from the information seeker to the effect that he is satisfied with the inspection of the record and file compliance report to the Commission within 2 weeks from the date of pronouncement of this order.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
