The Commission vide its Order No. SIC/J/A/171/2012/383 dated 14-11-2012 advised the complainant to deposit the requisite fee as per new rules to the Divisional Manager, J&K SFC Ext. Division, Bhaderwah for seeking the information with regard to his RTI application dated 07-07-2012 within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order and the Divisional Manager, J&K SFC Ext. Division, Bhaderwah was also directed to provide the information to the information seeker in case he deposits the requisite fee as prescribed within the new rules and send a compliance report to the Commission.

The information seeker, however, filed an application dated 17-05-2013 alleging therein the noncompliance of the aforesaid order of the Commission. After receiving the application, the Commission vide its notice bearing no. SIC/J/C/171/2012/2421-22 dated 04-06-2013 directed the PIO, J&K SFC, Bhaderwah

to appear before the Commission on 15-06-2013 for hearing of the case. In compliance to the aforesaid notice of the Commission, Sh. Tariq Hussain, Section Officer appeared on behalf of the PIO SFC, Ext. Division, Baderwah and apprised the Commission that the information as requested by the information seeker relating to photocopy of Service Book of Sh. Hem Raj and Sh. Mool Raj containing 6 & 7 leaves respectively was sent to the information seeker vide office letter no. 108/DM/SFC/B Dated 20-04-2013 under a registered cover. The information seeker was also requested to deposit an amount of Rs. 6496/- on account of Xerox charges enabling them to provide, rest of the information. The perusal of the application for non compliance shows that the information seeker has also requested for the details of salary (total amount of salary received) by Sh. Mool Raj and Sh. Hem Raj which is denied on the ground that the cost of information has not been deposited by the information seeker.

In view of the request of the complainant, the PIO is hereby directed to furnish the total amount of salary so far received by the aforesaid employees of the SFC, Baderwah to the information seeker free of cost within two weeks from the date of pronouncement of this order under an intimation to the Commission.

The complaint for non compliance is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
