Smt. Rani Devi in her complaint dated 25-10-2012 before the Commission has alleged that information furnished to her by the PIO in compliance to the Commission's order is not satisfactory and no revenue details of the land has been provided to her. She further alleged that direction issued by the Commission in its order dated 13-03-2012 to the concerned PIO to depute Tehsildar Settlement to make on spot inspection of the site in dispute and prepare the report reflecting the ownership and possession status of the land as per revenue record has not been provided to her. However, the Tehsildar Settlement Jammu vide No:STJ/R/1114 dated 02-07-2013 filed counter statement before the Commission and also apprised the Commission during the course of proceedings that information as sought by the information seeker has been furnished to her. However, the confusion is due to the new (209) and 301(previous) Khasra Nos for

the same piece of land because the new record compiled has come into use. The Tehsildar Settlement, Jammu further submitted that the Revenue Department is not maintaining the record regarding residences, however, the possession has been restored to one Fateh Ali on Khasra No. 301 Min measuring one marla in compliance to the court order and the Naqsha Dasti mentioning Khasra No. 209 has been provided to the complainant on her identification.

The Tehsildar Settlement, Jammu further informed the Commission that he will visit the spot within 3 weeks time and after completing the enquiry on the complaint and ascertaining the factual position he will apprise the concerned quarter after following the due procedure of law. The Tehsildar Settlement also requested the Commission that complainant be advised to follow the proper legal course. In view of the aforesaid submissions, complainant is advised to approach the proper legal forum for redressal of her grievances.

The complaint for non-compliance is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
