Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Raghubir Singh R/o CDA Road, Narwal Pain, Jammu Cantt. moved an application dated 02-03-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO/Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Jammu Cantt. seeking certain information.

The PIO O/o Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Jammu Cantt. furnished the information to the information seeker vide No:CBJ/RIA/2012-13/26 dated 02-04-2013. However, the information seeker was not satisfied with the information provided to him and he filed appeal dated 10-04-2013 before the Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Jammu Cantt. alleging therein that the information provided to him was incomplete and incorrect. The FAA/ Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Jammu Cantt. disposed of Ist appeal vide order No: CBJ/Adm/19/RTI-2005 dated 24-06-2013 with the observation that appellant has been advised to give specific reference or issue in which he feels that the information as given by the PIO on 2-04-2013 under letter

No:CBJ/RIA/2012-13/26 dated 2-04-2013 is deficient. FAA further observed that rest of the things are in nature of complaint and not for delivery of information. The information seeker again feeling aggrieved of the order of the FAA filed second appeal before the Commission on 13-06-2013. The matter was listed for hearing on 25-07-2013 and both the parties appeared before the Commission and after hearing both the parties and perusing the counter statement and appeal filed by appellant, the Commission is of the considered view that information as requested by the information seeker stands furnished to him within statutory period and there is no scope for interference with the decision of the FAA which is based on merit and was delivered after hearing both the parties. However, during the course of proceedings, the information seeker has alleged that he has not been provided information relating to query No. E of his RTI application especially the copy of the seizure memo which was prepared in presence of appellant and the Member namely Sh. Hardev Singh in G.B Pant Cantt. General Hospital Satwari Jammu. The PIO readily agreed to furnish the same to the information seeker.

In view of the aforesaid facts, it is hereby ordered that information with regard to seizure memo as requested by the information seeker in query No. E of RTI application may be furnished to him within 7 days from the date of pronouncement of this order under an intimation to the Commission.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
