The Assistant Commissioner Development Doda forwarded the RTI application of the information seeker to Block Development Officer, Thathri for further necessary action at his end. The BDO Thathri/PIO vide office letter No:BDOT/68-69 dated 30-01-2013 informed the information seeker to deposit an amount of Rs.3,79,836/- on account of information charges. Feeling aggrieved of the aforesaid order of the BDO, Thathri, the information seeker approached the District Development Commissioner, Doda/ the appellate authority under RTI Act, 2009 on 2-2-2013 with the request that the calculation sheet be provided to him as per SRO 279 dated 30-08-2012, thus enabling him to deposit the actual charges for the information applied for. The information seeker requested the BDO Thathri vide PC/2013/09 dated 26-03-2013 to provide the information through diskettes and the amount required to be deposited for the same. The information seeker received no response from the District Development Commissioner and BDO Thathri. Thus, feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of both the PIO as well as FAA, the information seeker filed complaint before the Commission dated 30-04-2013 requesting therein that the information sought by him may be provided to him as per SRO 279 (The Jammu and Kashmir Right to Information Rules, 2012) and in this regard direction be issued to BDO, Thathri.

Perusal of the RTI application of the information seeker shows that the information sought by him is voluminous in nature. Keeping in view the facts and

circumstances of this case, it would be appropriate to allow the information seeker an opportunity to inspect the record in the office of BDO Thathri, as it would save necessary cost of information demanded from the information seeker and also time for preparing the same. During the course of proceedings held today, the information seeker requested the Commission that he would like to inspect the record in the office of BDO Thathri and seek photocopies of relevant documents at his expense. Thus keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the BDO Thathri/PIO is hereby directed to allow the information seeker a facility to inspect the record in his office during working hours and in case the information seeker requires the photocopies of any relevant document he may be provided the same at his own expense. The BDO Thathri is further directed to fix up the date and time for inspection of record in his office in mutual consultation with the information seeker and file compliance report to the Commission.

The complaint is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
