Briefly the facts in this complaint are that Sh. Ex. NK. Kirpal Singh R/o H.No. 68, Sector-C, Sainik Colony, Jammu moved an application dated 11-12-2012 under J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 before the PIO O/o Municipal Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation, Jammu seeking certain information regarding *construction works of roads, blocks, black topping of roads, drains, deep drains, development of parks and other allied construction works in Municipal ward no. 69 Jammu Municipal Corporation, Jammu comprising sector A,B,C and G of Sainik Colony Jammu and Ward No. 70 comprising sector D, E and F Sainik Colony, Jammu.* The PIO forwarded the application of the information seeker vide office letter No. JMC/S/RTI/Comp/721 dated 13-12-2012 to Joint Commissioner(W), Municipal Corporation, Jammu for further necessary action at his end. Sh. T.L Thappa, Executive Engineer appeared before the Commission and apprised the Commission that information sought by the information seeker was voluminous in nature and had to be collected from

different sources and it virtually amounted to generating the information afresh and submitted before the commission that delay in providing the information to the information seeker was not intentional. The PIO further submitted that there was no malafide intention in denying the information to the information seeker and if there is any delay in providing the information it is purely circumstantial in nature. The PIO has also apprised the Commission that the information has already been provided to the information seeker and also submitted a photocopy of the receipt duly acknowledged by the information seeker. The PIO also submitted a complete set of information to the Commission which has been brought on the file for reference and record.

Perusal of the information shows that it was virtually an exercise which amounted to generate the information afresh and consumed a lot of time in compiling the same. Thus, there is no intentional delay on the part of the PIO/ Executive Engineer, Trikuta Complex, Dogra Hall, Jammu in furnishing the information to the information seeker. The information already stands furnished to the information seeker and thus no further direction in the matter is required.

The complaint is accordingly disposed of.
