The Commission vide its decision No:SIC/A/234/2012/385 dated 08-01-2013 directed the PIO/Tehsildar, Jammu to provide information to the information seeker/appellant and send it either through official runner or through registered post with a copy to the Commission as compliance within 15 days from the the date of receipt of this order. However, the information seeker filed an application dated 13-02-2013 before the Commission alleging therein for non-compliance of the aforesaid order of the Commission and prayed that PIO be directed to provide the requisite information to the appellant. The information seeker also moved second application for non-compliance dated 26-06-2013 before the Commission through his Counsel Sh. Rajinder Jamwal Advocate. Taking cognizance of the complaint for non-compliance, the Commission summoned Asstt. Commissioner Revenue, Jammu and Tehsildar Territorial, Jammu in order to ascertain compliance of the aforesaid decision of the Commission. Both

Asstt. Commissioner Revenue, Jammu and Tehsildar Territorial, Jammu apprised the Commission that information sought by the information seeker and as available in the office record was furnished to the information seeker. On the last date of hearing i.e 26-07-2013 Tehsildar Territorial, Jammu furnished a set of information to the information seeker during the course of proceedings and the information seeker was also advised to go through it and point out inconsistencies if any.

During the course of proceedings held today i.e. 26-09-2013, the information seeker expressed the desire to inspect the relevant record relating to his RTI application. The Tehsildar Territorial, Jammu agreed to provide him an opportunity to access the record in his office. Keeping in view the request of the information seeker and assurance given by the Tehsildar Territorial, Jammu, it is hereby ordered that the information seeker be provided an opportunity to access the record in the office of Tehsildar Territorial, Jammu on any working during office hours. However, the parties are at liberty to settle the date and time for inspection of record which may be mutually convenient to both of them and in case the information seeker requires the certified copies of relevant documents, the PIO is directed to provide him the same and file compliance report.

The complaint for non-compliance is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
