Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Mohan Singh S/o Lt. Krishan Singh R/o Nai Basti (Jar) Distt. Samba moved an application dated 04-03-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the Inspector General of Police, Jammu against Sh. Ramesh Lal Sharma SHO posted at Police Station, Ramgarh, Samba seeking interalia details about the land bearing Khasra no. 172/1.

The complainant also preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 16-04-2013 before the SSP, Samba in which he asked for report of inspection relating to Khasra no. 172/1 by the SHO Police Station, Ramgarh, Samba. The claim of the complainant is that land belongs to him and has been changed into government land. Thus, feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the police authorities, the information seeker filed a complaint before the Commission dated 26-06-2013 in which he has alleged that SHO Ramesh Lal and Patwari submitted a wrong information and cancelled his FIR and

showed a new no. 172/1 in the revenue record which is not existing on the ground, and requested that SHO and Patwari may be directed to furnish him the requisite report of the investigation/enquiry conducted in the said matter. During the course of proceedings held today, the PIO informed the Commission that the information as available in the office record has already been furnished to the information seeker and in all magnanimity he agreed to refurnish the same to the complainant.

In view of the aforesaid facts and observations, the PIO/Dy.S.P. Hqrs.Samba is hereby directed to furnish the photocopies of the relevant documents relating to Khasra no. 172/1 about which investigation/enquiry was conducted by SHO Police Station, Ramgarh, Samba along with the statement of witnesses if any and subject to the availability in the office record within 10 days from the date of receipt of this order under an intimation to the Commission.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
