Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Smt. Shashi Bala W/o Sh. Shiv Charan, H. No. 131-A, Dream Land City, Muthi Jammu moved an application dated 25-04-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO/Hon'ble High Court of J&K, Jammu seeking certain information relating to status of file wherein a complaint was made against Judge Aarti Mohan and Advocate Neena Mishra.

Having received no response from the PIO, the information seeker filed an appeal dated 01-06-2013 before the FAA, High Court of J&K, Jammu and as alleged by the information seeker it has not been

adjudicated and disposed of till date. Thus, feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO/FAA, the appellant filed second appeal dated 25-07-2013 before the Commission. The Commission after receiving the second appeal directed the PIO vide office notice No:SIC/J/A/190/2013/3196 dated 5-08-2013 to file counter reply to the Commission within 7 days from the date of receipt of the notice. In compliance to the Commission's notice, PIO/High Court of J&K, Jammu vide office letter No:1687 dated 5-09-2012 informed the Commission that the information sought by the appellant has been supplied to the appellant vide office letter No:1331 dated 16-07-2013 and also enclosed a copy of the information for perusal of the Commission.

During the course of proceedings held today, Sh. Ashok Kumar Sharma who represented the information seeker was provided a photo copy of information sent at the residential address and was advised to contact the PIO in case he is not satisfied with the information. The PIO also assured the Commission telephonically that in case the appellant wants to raise certain queries about the information provided to her, she is at liberty to visit his office on any working day and sort out the queries raised in the RTI application. The PIO requested for exemption from personal appearance before the Commission as he was busy in some official assignment in the High Court of J&K Jammu. The request was considered and allowed.

It is apparent from the aforesaid facts that the information sought by the appellant in her RTI application stands furnished to her. No further direction in the matter is required.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
