Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Mohd. Sadiq R/o C-3 Village Enclave East Extension 1/C, Trikuta Nagar, Jammu moved an application dated 16-07-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO O/o Deputy Commissioner, Jammu seeking information relating to the land measuring 5 kanal 2 marla bearing khasra no. 781 situated at Village Deeli, Niabat Digiana, Jammu which was transferred under Roshni Act for ownership rights in favour of one Sh. Bansilal S/o Sh. Isher Dass R/o 90-A, Gandhi Nagar vide mutation no. 5386J. Information required:-

1. Copy of Order.
2. Copy of all documents in support of file submitted by Sh. Bansilal.
3. Detail of fees deposited by Sh. Bansilal.
4. Status and title of above said land.

The appellant has alleged that the PIO did not provide the requisite information within the statutory period. Thus, feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO, the appellant preferred 1st appeal dated 19-08-2013 before the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu which has not been adjudicated and disposed of till date. Thus, feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO as well as the

FAA, the appellant knocked the doors of the Commission by filing appeal dated: 23-09-2013. After receiving 2nd appeal, the Commission vide office notice no. SIC/J/A/237/2013/3969 dated 01-10-2013 directed the PIO to send counter reply to the Commission within 7 days from the receipt of the notice. However, no reply was received from the PIO and the matter was listed for hearing on 22-10-2013 at Jammu office of the Commission and on that day AC(R), Jammu could not cause his appearance before the Commission due to some official engagement and telephonically requested for adjournment. The matter was again listed for hearing on 04-11-2013. During the course of proceedings held today, the appellant requested that he may be allowed an opportunity to inspect the record relating to the above khasra no. Keeping in view the request of the appellant, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Jammu is hereby directed to provide an opportunity to the information seeker to access the record relating to Khasra no. 781 situated at Village Deeli, Niabat Digiana, Jammu in his office on a working day during office hours and in case the information seeker requires the photocopies of relevant documents that may be provided to him free of cost within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order under an intimation to the Commission. The parties are directed to settle the date and time for inspection of record which may be mutually convenient to both of them.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
