Briefly the facts in this complaint are that Sh. Amarjeet Singh S/o Sh. Sansar Singh R/o Sawani, Tehsil & Distt. Ramban moved an application dated 21-06-2013 under J&K RTI Act, 2009 before the PIO/Assistant Commissioner Development, Ramban whereunder he sought certain information relating to Panchayat Sawani for the year *2011-12 & 2012-13*.

The Assistant Commissioner Development, Ramban forwarded the application of the information seeker to Block Development Officer, Ramban vide office No:ACDR/RTI/2013-14/1229-30 dated 21-06-2013 with a direction to provide the desired information to the information seeker strictly as per the RTI rules under an intimation to his office. Meanwhile, the information seeker was asked by the BDO Ramban to deposit an amount of Rs. 8,050/- on account

of Photostat charges of all the record of Rural Development of Panchayat Sawani for the year 2011-12 and 2012-13. The complainant deposited the said amount on 24-07-2013. The BDO Ramban furnished the requisite information to the information seeker in respect of Panchayat Sawani, Block Ramban on 23-08-2013 which has been duly acknowledged by the complainant. BDO Ramban furnished the aforesaid receipt for perusal of the Commission and the same has been brought on the file for reference and record.

During the course of proceedings held today, the office of the Commission contacted complainant on telephone and inquired about the receipt of information and disposal of his RTI application by the BDO Ramban and accordingly, apprised the Commission that he has received the requisite information as sought by him in his RTI application and also informed the Commission that cost of the information deposited by him in the office of BDO Ramban has also been refunded to him. Thus, information as sought by the information seeker stands already furnished to him and that too free of cost. Thus, the complaint filed by the information seeker is without merit and dismissed.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
