Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Pritam Singh Saini (Editor) Daily Nawa-I-Waqat Azeem Lower Muthi, Akalpur Morh, P.O Udhewala, Teh. & Distt. Jammu moved an application dated 27-05-2013 under J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 before the PIO/Secretary, Jammu Municipal Corporation, Jammu whereunder he sought interalia certain information relating to file no. STJ/29/2013 dated 12-04-2013 in the case titled Sushil Kumar V/s Joint Commissioner (A).

The PIO/Secretary, JMC, Jammu furnished the requisite information to the information seeker vide letter no. JMC/S/RTI/1784 dated 20-07-2013. However, the information seeker has alleged in his 2nd appeal before the Commission that he has not received the aforesaid information. The

PIO during the course of proceedings held today agreed to refurnish the information to the information seeker.

In view of the aforesaid facts and assurance given by the PIO, it is hereby ordered that the information as sought by the information seeker in his RTI application and the letter dated 20-07-2013 containing the information be furnished to the information seeker within a week's time from the date of receipt of this order.

The appellant is also directed to provide feedback to the Commission about the impact of RTI Act and its benefits to the general public including the purposive use of the information sought by him within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
