Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Bishan Dutt S/o Lt. Sh. Ram Saran R/o Village Patti, P.O Raya, Teh. & Distt. Samba moved an application dated 04-07-2013 under J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 before the PIO O/o Deputy Commissioner, Samba whereunder he sought information relating to *total "Gair Mumkin Khad"/Banjar Kadeem land sold power of attorney given by the Maqbooja Malkin" out of their left out claim and mutated by the Revenue Authorities.*

The appellant has alleged in his 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before the Commission that the PIO did not provide him complete information within the statutory period. Thus, feeling aggrieved of in action on the part of the PIO, he preferred 1<sup>st</sup> Appeal dated 05-08-2013 before the Deputy Commissioner, Samba which has not been adjudicated and disposed of till date. The matter was listed for hearing on 22-11-2013 and again on 09-12-2013. During the course of proceedings held today, the PIO informed the Commission that the information as sought by the information

seeker was voluminous in nature and have to be collected from old record. The entire exercise involved disproportionately diverts the resources of the public authority which is having a meager staff at his disposal. In spite of these limitations partly the information was already provided to the information seeker within the statutory period as the information was voluminous in nature and rest of the information was provided on 06-12-2013 and he expressed his satisfaction over the same.

In view of the aforesaid facts, it is apparent that the information as sought by the information seeker in his RTI application stands already furnished to him and as such there is no direction in the matter is required.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
