



*iii. About if any encroachment is made over the land comprising Kh. No. 494 in Village Deeli, Teh. Jammu by Allotees namely Ranjit Singh and others (above in 'I'). If so under what rule, norms and order Ranjit Singh & Others (above in 'I') have encroached upon the land comprising Kh. No.494.*

*iv. About what measures under law the Department shall initiate to evict the encroachers (above) in 'I' from the land under Kh. No. 494, Vill. Deeli, so that the Allotee of Kh. No. 494 gets his due share of allotted land out of Kh. No. 494.*

The PIO forwarded the application of the information seeker to Tehsildar (Settlement), Jammu vide office letter No:DCJ/PIO/RTI/2012-13/2755-56 dated 21-09-2012 under Section 5(4) of J&K Right to Information Act, 2009. Tehsildar (Settlement) Jammu further referred the application of the information seeker to Naib Tehsildar, Digiana and directed him to provide the requisite information within four days positively. The Naib Tehsildar, Digiana and Patwari Deeli accordingly prepared the information and furnished the same to the Tehsildar (Settlement) for onward transmission to the information seeker. Accordingly, the PIO furnished the information to the information seeker which contained report from Tehsildar (Settlement) vide office letter No:DCJ/PIO/RTI/2012-13/3228 dated 10-11-2012. However, the information seeker was not satisfied with the aforesaid information and filed an appeal dated 17-12-2012 before the First Appellate Authority/Deputy Commissioner, Jammu. The First appeal of the appellant still remains subjudice and has not been adjudicated and disposed of by the First Appellate Authority within statutory period. Thus, feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the FAA, the information seeker preferred 2nd appeal before the Commission dated 05-02-2013. After receiving the second appeal, Commission vide its Notice No:SIC/J/A/25/2013/982-83 dated 26-02-2013 directed the First Appellate Authority and PIO to file counter reply within 07 days after receipt of the notice and finally the matter was listed and parties were

directed to remain present on 01-04-2013 for hearing of the second appeal by the Commission.

During the course of proceedings, the PIO/Tehsildar (Settlement), Jammu submitted a revised set of information (photostat) which is placed in file for reference and record. PIO informed the Commission that revised information as requested by the information seeker has been provided to him and the information seeker has also acknowledged the receipt of the same. The information seeker also expressed his satisfaction about the information provided to him and informed the Commission that it corresponds to his request made in the RTI application.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
