Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Sh. Rashu Khanna R/o H.No. 579, Near Subash Nagar, P.O. Jammu moved an application dated 12-12-2012 under J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 before the PIO / Asstt. Settlement Commissioner, J&K seeking the following information:-

Query No. 1

The certified copy of Letter No. SC/823/Phy-06, Dated 14-05-2007 sent to State Vigilance Organization (SVO) for probing into the matter.

Query No. 2

Total area of land falling under the Khasra No. 355 situated at village Upper Thather presently named Karan Vihar Colony, Jammu.

Query No. 3

Total land falling under the survey number 373 situated at village Upper Thather presently named Karan Vihar Colony, Jammu.

Query No. 4

Total land sold out by the owners falling under Khasra No. 355 against his recorded share till date situated at village Upper Thather presently named Karan Vihar colony, Jammu.

Query No. 5

Total land sold out by the owners falling under Khasra No. 373 against his recorded share till date situated at village Upper Thather presently named Karan Vihar colony, Jammu.

The PIO / Assistant Settlement Commissioner, J&K after receiving the application of the information seeker forwarded it to Tehsildar (Territorial), Jammu vide office letter no. SC/Phy/2011/105/20 dated 24-12-2012 for necessary action at his end. PIO / Tehsildar (T), Jammu vide letter no. Teh/J/RTI/11-12/462 dated 19-01-2013 furnished the information to the information seeker as available in office record.

However, the information seeker knocked the doors of the 1st Appellate Authority by filing an appeal dated 14-01-2013 against the PIO / Tehsildar, Jammu for not providing the complete information. The FAA / Settlement Commissioner, J&K adjudicated and disposed of the appeal within the statutory period as envisaged under the J&K RTI Act, 2009 on 29-01-2013.

During the course of proceedings, the information seeker informed the Commission that he has received the information as requested in his RTI application and is satisfied with the information provided to him. In view of the aforesaid submission of the information seeker no further direction in the matter is required.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
