This case is regarding an RTI application filed by Ms. Sunhera Ashraf, a resident of the State before PIO, JKSSB, Srinagar on 24-05-2014 received in the office of PIO on 26-05-2014. When no response was received from PIO, appellant preferred first appeal before First Appellate Authority, JKSSB on 01-07-2014. Again not having received any response from FAA/PIO, appellant filed 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal in this Commission on 20-08-2014 requesting Commission to direct the concerned to provide information to her. Brief facts of the case reveal that appellant filed an RTI application seeking information with regard to points / marks obtained by her in written test conducted on 17-09-2013 and points / marks obtained in viva voce conducted on 19-04-2014 for the post of Teacher District Srinagar under Notification No. 03 of 2012 dated: 28-12-2012 and Notification No. 05 of 2013 dated: 02-03-2013. Besides this, she wanted information about approved criteria of the qualification passed through Board or University. The Case was heard time to time and every time PIO took the plea that selection process for the said notifications was still incomplete, hence information could not be provided. During the last hearing dated: 30-10-2014, Mr. A.G.Zargar, Administrative Officer-cum-PIO, JKSSB, Divisional Office, Kashmir informed the Commission that selection process was completed on 15-10-2014 and now information has been provided to the information

seeker vide No. SSB/DIV/Kash/RTI/14/522/2124-25 dated: 28-10-2014. A copy of the said information was also provided to the information seeker during the proceedings before the Commission. Since information has reached information seeker, hence, there is no further action in the 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal proceedings except that information was given late. Therefore, Mr. A.G.Zargar, Administrative Officer-cum-PIO, JKSSB, Divisional Office, Kashmir is directed to explain why penalty may not be imposed on him for not providing information within stipulated time, as prescribed under J&K RTI Act, 2009. His reply if any must reach the Commission within 15 days of the receipt of this order. Meanwhile during last hearing, Commission vide its order dated: 30-10-2014 required information seeker to furnish his reply whether the above said information given is complete and correct. In pursuance of above said Commission's order, information seeker vide his letter dated: 21-11-2014 has informed the Commission that the information so provided is incomplete and biased and thus has filed a complaint under Section 15 of the Act. There is a separate proceedings procedure under Section 15 and registry to process complaint accordingly.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Appeal is accordingly disposed of.
